Member Code of Conduct

This code of conduct outlines your expected behaviour as a member of SU Activities and your club. It aligns with the Student Unions' constitution, byelaws and policies. All members should read and agree to the code of conduct. Failure to adhere to this may result in repercussions not limited to termination of club membership, imposed bans or club disbandment.

Members will:

- Recognise and respect the rights of all participants and champion the rights of every individual to be included.
- To actively challenge any forms of discrimination e.g. sexism, racism, homophobia and transphobia within the club and raise any concerns to the Students Union.
- Not to engage in abusive language or behaviour during club activities, fixtures, events on and off campus. Respect all students, visiting students, Student Union and University staff and match or event officials. There will be zero-tolerance taken to abuse and discrimination.
- Actively challenge any form of discrimination and to create a safe and welcoming environment. To raise concerns or issues with the committee or the Students' Union where appropriate.
- Ensure you treat all your members with dignity and respect whilst promoting a safe environment free from sexual assault and misconduct.
- Not engage in peer pressure or what is perceived to be peer pressure during social activities and that any games during socials are opt-in.
- Not engage in any behaviour that brings the club, Students' Union or University reputation into disrepute.
